

# The Scenic Route to Peggy's Cove

## *A Visit to Peggy's Cove and Nearby Coastal Villages and Vistas*

### Polly Cove Trail

Polly Cove is Peggy's Cove without the village and the tourists (or the history or amenities).  
The views are spectacular



The unofficial and unmarked (but distinct) trail runs south from the parking area towards the Atlantic coast, 500 meters distant, and hidden from view by a low long ridge of granite. The first part of the trail crosses the barrens, then gently ascends the ridge. The thick alders are popular with birds and insects. The trail tops out at the concrete foundation for a never-constructed building, and from here the view is wonderful. To the west you'll see the crowds milling about Peggy's Cove, just two km away, but at Polly Cove it is always uncrowded, although the spot is known to local walkers. Several less distinct, but still obvious paths, lead off this main path, either eventually following the coastline west for about a kilometre, or to the east for two kilometres.



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
